How does Granite Bay Acceptance collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you:  apply for a loan or give us your income information  provide employment information or give us your contact information  show your drivers license  We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only:  • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your credit worthiness  • affiliates from using your information to market to you  • sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you  State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more information on your rights under state law.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choice to limit sharing will apply to all joint account holders.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  • Our affiliates include Orion Acceptance Corp., Loan A Rangers LLC. and Western Sierra Acceptance Corp
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  • Nonaffiliates we share with can include credit unions, insurance companies, and direct marketing companies.

Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  • Our joint marketing partners include financial service companies.
Other Important Information	
For California Residents	We will not share information we collect about you with nonaffiliated third parties, except as permitted by California law, such as to process your transactions or to maintain your account.
For Vermont Residents	We will not share information we collect about you with nonaffiliated third parties, except as permitted by Vermont law, such as to process your transactions or to maintain your account. In addition, we will not share information about your creditworthiness with our affiliates except with your authorization.
